

July 29, 1945. For protection against attacking enemy aircraft, US-operated radar was established on many of the islands of the Ryukyu chain which stretches between Kyushu, Japan, and Formosa, China. The islands were occupied by the US in 1945 and returned to Japan in 1953. This radar set-up is on Tori Shima. The tent at the left is the living quarters for the ISCOM radio unit.
