

### Family Subsistence Supplemental Allowance FAQs

Eligibility is based on the *income* for all members of the household and the *number* of people living in the household. The following table indicates the income limit for a given number of persons in a household. For example, if you have 5 people living in your household then you must have income below \$2,836.00 per month (48 states) to be eligible. The table is provided as a means of allowing you to make a rough determination of whether or not you are eligible. To see if you are actually eligible just continue to the next page where you will be asked to provide the information needed to determine whether you are eligible and the dollar amount for which you are eligible. After filling out the form you can print it and then take the printed form and documentation of income to your Service designated point of contact.
