COMMUNITY SERVICE AWARD PROGRAM

Army Regulation (AR) 608-1, Army Community Service, mandates a system to recognize those who volunteer. The Community Service Award Program enhances the Volunteer of the Quarter Award Program.

APPLICABILITY

Applies to all organizations, activities and individuals, and their families, assigned or attached to Fort Gordon.

AWARDS

The Community Service Awards consist of:

- a. Community Service Award. Awarded to those who have demonstrated outstanding support of programs and services on the installation.
- b. Community Service Award-Honor Award. Awarded to those who have demonstrated continued exceptional performance and extensive personal commitment to a specific service or project which has contributed to the improvement and/or expansion of programs or services to the community.
- c. Community Service Award-Distinguished Honor Award. Awarded to those who have provided meritorious service in a number of leadership positions held over a period of years. This is a volunteer leadership award.

PROCEDURES

- a. Nominations may be made by any individual or organization/activity on the installation.
- b. Nominations will be submitted using FG Form 6570 (Recommendation for Fort Gordon Community Service Award) or similar format to this headquarters, ATTN: IMSE-GOR-MWA.
- c. The Commanding General or his/her designated representative will present all Community Service Awards at any appropriate ceremony.
