

Environmental Checklist Requirements for Training Areas (NOT SUB-TAs)

- I.** UNIT must schedule TA(s) 30 days in advance using RFMSS.
 - II.** UNIT must submit an Environmental Checklist, for each TA, to Range Control **by email** 30 days in advance. (Range Control # 706-791-5008/9935)
 - A.** Obtain blank Environmental Checklists at Range Control website or ENRMO website:

ENRMO: <http://gordon.army.mil/dpw/enrmo/nepa.html> (click on "A Shorter Checklist used to plan for Training Actions")
- Note:** Range Control and ITAM will review and forward checklist(s) to ENRMO for approval. ENRMO approves training activity at each site and prepares a Record of Environmental Consideration ("R.E.C.").
- III.** Prior to the first day of training, UNIT must pick up approved Environmental Checklist and "R.E.C." at ENRMO (Address: 15th Street, Bldg. 14500, Room A112)
 - 1.) Unit OIC (E7 and above) must be prepared to sign the R.E.C.
 - IV.** UNIT must provide Approved Environmental Checklist and "R.E.C." to Range Control when signing for training area.

NOTE:

- 1. RANGE CONTROL REQUIRES THE APPROVED ENVIRONMENTAL CHECKLIST AND R.E.C. PRIOR TO OCCUPANCY OF TRAINING SITE.**
- 2. ENVIRONMENTAL CHECKLIST MUST BE SUBMITTED FOR ALL TRAINING SITES WITH GRID COORDINATES (EXCLUDING SUB-TAs).**
- 3. IT IS CRITICAL THAT THE POC INFORMATION BE INCLUDED ON THE CHECKLIST TO CLARIFY ANY QUESTIONS BY RANGE CONTROL OR ENRMO.**
