All callers should feel that this office is accessible to them and that their concerns have been heard and understood even if solutions to their problems are not always available.
3. As the Garrison Commander, I have many resources that can be employed to resolve problems or disputes. Individuals should first address their problems or concerns with their chain of command, to the supervisory structure of the organization to which they are assigned, or to the head of the Garrison directorate that can best provide the help they need. Most problems and concerns can best be addressed through those means. Anyone, however, may request to see me directly, at any time. Upon such request, arrangements will be made for an appointment through the Garrison Executive Officer.
