SUBJECT: Installation Food Service Policy Memorandum No. 52 – Basic Allowance for Subsistence (BAS) Recoupement/Payroll Deduction for Field Operation

1. References:

- a. AR 30-22, 24 July 2012, Army Food Program.
- b. AR 600-38, Meal Card Management System.

2. The purpose of this memorandum is to establish policy and procedures for deduction of payroll for all units of Brigade/Battalion levels and below during field training exercises.

3. When meals are available during field duty, commanders must ensure that BAS recoupement/suspension for enlisted Soldiers or payroll deduction for officers is initiated to effect all required reimbursements, beginning with the first meal and ending with the last meal. A written action to affect BAS recoupement/suspension is authorized. The unit or PAC clerk will use personnel actions. The DA Form 4187 will be prepared three workdays after completion of field duty and forwarded to the Finance and Accounting Office (FAO) for action.


4. Reimbursement from the first meal available through 14 days will be established through BAS recoupement. After excess of 14 days the BAS entitlement will be suspended. Reimbursement through FAO action (payroll deduction) will affect officers participating in field duty for all meals available during field duty, whether consumed or not. Soldiers authorized Subsistence-In-Kind (SIK) will continue to use their Garrison meal cards for identification purposes.

5. VIPs and other distinguished visitors who are not participating in field duty are not required to seek reimbursement through FAO, but will be required to pay cash for the meal at the time of consumption.
