MEMORANDUM FOR All Personnel, U.S. Army Garrison

SUBJECT: Garrison Commander's Policy Memorandum No. 78 – Burials in Private Cemeteries on Fort Gordon.

1. Reference: AR 210-190, Post Cemeteries.
2. This policy applies to any individual requesting burial in a private cemetery on Fort Gordon.
3. Purpose: The purpose of this policy is to establish the requirements necessary for allowing new burials within one of the existing 42 private cemeteries.
4. Procedure: The requirements for new burials are as follows:
 - a. Documentary evidence, provided to the Point of Contact (POC) for this action, that the person who will/wishes to be buried has a direct familial relationship with someone already buried in a private cemetery.
 - b. New burials must be within the existing boundary of the private cemetery.
 - c. All burial costs will be covered by private funds.
 - d. Once burial has been approved, the POC for this action must be notified 2 days in advance of burial to coordinate escort from gate to cemetery.
