FORT GORDON, Ga. – Media are invited to attend the Brain Injury Awareness Education Seminar and Open House at the Dwight D. Eisenhower Army Medical Center on March 7, 2014 from 11 a.m. until 2 p.m. in the DDEAMC Neuroscience and Rehabilitation Center.

To kick off Brain Injury Awareness month, the Director of the Neuroscience Traumatic Brain Injury Clinic, Dr. John Rigg, will conduct a Brain Injury seminar on March 7, 2014 from 11 a.m. until 12 p.m., followed by an open house celebration from 12 p.m. until 2 p.m.

Rigg will discuss the impact of combat on stress levels and post concussive symptoms and the Traumatic Brain Injury Clinic's holistic approaches to treatment and management of TBI.

“There are physicians out there who believe that medication is not always the answer, we look for new ideas to treat post concussive injuries with a more holistic approach.” said Rigg.
