MARINE MUD CHALLENGE 2014

FORT GORDON, GA – The Marine Corps Detachment of Fort Gordon is hosting its 7th Annual Marine Mud Challenge, Saturday, May 3rd, at 8 a.m. with teams starting throughout the day. The course is located at the corner of 19th Street and Chamberlain Ave. on Fort Gordon.

Participants, 13 and older, will try to conquer the 5 mile off-road trail with more than 30 military style obstacles, such as the 15 foot high cargo nets, free standing 7' high walls, a rope bridge, mud pits and 200,000 gallons of water in a 4'+ deep pit.

A Children's Challenge one mile off-road course is also available that has more than 7 kid sized obstacles, that will be open throughout the day.

All proceeds go to the installation's Morale, Welfare, and Recreation program in support of Fort Gordon service members and their families.
