### FORT GORDON HOSTS SUMMER CAMP FOR JROTC

FORT GORDON, GA – The Regimental Noncommissioned Officers Academy (RNCOA) hosts Camp Semaphore at Fort Gordon Monday, 2 June to Thursday, 5 June. Opening ceremony will take place at 11 a.m. in the Signal Theater on Barnes Ave.

Camp Semaphore is a summer camp for area high school students enrolled in the Junior Reserve Officer Training Corps (JROTC) program. Approximately 200 cadets from 14 area Georgia High Schools are attending the camp.

Training includes land navigation, rappel tower, first aid, one rope bridge and waterborne safety.

The camp provides cadets a challenging, meaningful and practical learning experience while developing leadership, teamwork and citizenship skills. It also builds self-confidence and discipline through hands-on adventure and team building training exercises.
