#### COMMANDING GENERAL GETS SECOND STAR

FORT GORDON, GA – The Department of the Army has announced Brigadier General Alan R. Lynn for promotion to the rank of major general. The promotion will take place Wednesday, Feb. 16 at 3 p.m., Leitner Conference Center on Fort Gordon.

BG Lynn has served in uniform nearly 32 years since his graduation as the ROTC Distinguished Military Graduate at California University of Pennsylvania in 1979. He has served at all levels of leadership to include several overseas commands and several at the Pentagon. He was assigned to the Pentagon when it was attacked on “9-11.”

BG Lynn deployed and served in Operations Desert Shield and Desert Storm, Operation Joint Forge (Bosnia/Herzegovina) and Operations Iraqi Freedom and Enduring Freedom.

On July 21, 2010 BG Alan R. Lynn became the Army’s 35<sup>th</sup> Chief of Signal and Commanding General, U.S. Army Signal Center of Excellence and Fort Gordon.
