#### FORT GORDON CONDUCTS ANNUAL ANTI-TERRORISM EXERCISE

FORT GORDON, GA – Fort Gordon will conduct the annual anti-terrorism exercise beginning Monday, June 13 to Thursday, June 16.

Military and civilian personnel should expect more security searches and delays while traveling into and on the installation on those days. It is recommended that personnel postpone non-official business on the installation until the exercise is over.

Exercise scenarios will occur at various locations on the installation with simulation of casualty like environments, simulated explosive devices, and starter gunfire to train installation employees and various emergency response personnel.

We ask all personnel to be extra vigilant during this exercise and this heightened level of security. This is only an exercise.
