### SEPTEMBER 11 REMEMBRANCE

FORT GORDON, GA – Sunday, Sept. 11 at 8:46 a.m. Fort Gordon will observe two minutes of silence in memory of the nearly three thousand who died in the September 11, 2001 attacks on the World Trade Center, Pentagon and the plane crash in Pennsylvania.

8:30 a.m. – Emergency vehicles will be positioned at key intersections and all gates on Fort Gordon. All employees will move outside, where mission requirements allow.

8:45 a.m. – Department of Emergency Services Director will give a one minute verbal warning on the installation for execution.

8:46 a.m. – Sirens will sound simulating the first strike on the World Trade Center. Colors lowered to Half Staff during siren blare.

8:47 a.m. – Sirens end, playing of Taps...installation moment of silence, all render proper respect.

Flag will remain at half staff until retreat at 5 p.m.
