FORT GORDON PARTICIPATES IN VERERANS DAY

FORT GORDON, GA – Military personnel from Fort Gordon will participate in Veterans Day activities on Friday, November 11.

Command Sergeant Major Ronald Pflieger, U.S. Army Signal Center of Excellence and Fort Gordon will speak at the Georgia War Nursing Home of Augusta on 15th Street at 9 a.m. The Signal Corps Band and color guard will take part in the ceremony.

Grand Marshal for the CSRA Veterans Day Parade on Broad Street will be Major General Alan Lynn, commanding general, U.S. Army Signal Center of Excellence and Fort Gordon. Also participating in the parade is a Joint Service Color Guard and military supporting units from Fort Gordon. The parade begins at 10 a.m.

Ceremonies at the Monument of the All Wars begins at 11 a.m. at 4th and Broad Street will feature remarks by Major General Alan Lynn, and participation of the Joint Color Guard, firing detail, and Signal Corps Band.

A Veterans Day ceremony will also take place at 1 p.m. at the Heroes' Overlook, 10th and Levee Streets on the Riverwalk in downtown Augusta. Major General Alan Lynn will attend, with participation by the Signal Corps Band, firing detail and bugler.
