#### FORT GORDON PARTICIPATES IN VETERANS DAY

FORT GORDON, GA – Military personnel from Fort Gordon will participate in Veterans Day activities throughout the area on Monday, November 12<sup>th</sup>.

Major General LaWarren V. Patterson, commanding general, U.S. Army Signal Center of Excellence and Fort Gordon, will speak at the Georgia War Veterans Nursing Home of Augusta on 15<sup>th</sup> Street at 9 a.m. The Signal Corps Band and color guard will take part in the ceremony.

Major General Patterson will also serve as the grand marshal for the CSRA Veterans Day Parade on Broad Street. Also, participating in the parade are a Joint Service Color Guard and military supporting units from Fort Gordon. The parade begins at 10 a.m.

The North Augusta American Legion, Post 71 will conduct a Veterans Day Ceremony at 11 a.m. at the Wade Hampton Veteran's Park, Georgia Ave., North Augusta. Guest speaker will be Col. Robert A. Barker, Fort Gordon garrison commander.

Ceremonies at the All Wars Monument begins at 11 a.m. at 4<sup>th</sup> and Broad Street, downtown Augusta. The Joint Color Guard, firing detail, and Signal Corps Band will take part, and Major General Patterson will be the guest speaker.

A Veterans Day ceremony will also take place at 1 p.m. at the Heroes' Overlook on 10<sup>th</sup> Street at the Riverwalk in downtown Augusta. Participating will be the Signal Corps Band, a firing detail and a bugler.
