REGISTRATION UNDER WAY FOR NEW AUTOMATED POST ENTRY SYSTEM

FORT GORDON, GA – Open registration is under way for the post's Automated Installation Entry (AIE) Security System

When the system is fully implemented, personnel entering the installation will be required to swipe their identification card at post access points. In order for the person to be granted access, the ID card must be registered with the system.

The requirement to register applies to all ID cardholders with access to the installation: military personnel, family members, civilian employees and retirees.

In order to register, individuals need to possess a Department of Defense identification card. For personnel with more than one ID card (such as retirees or reservists who also work on post) once an ID is registered, all ID cards should be registered. Non-DOD ID card holders will not be registered; they will continue to enter the installation via established visitor policies.

Registration can be performed at Gate 1 Visitor Control Monday through Friday from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m. or the Military Police Administration office in Darling Hall Monday through Friday from 1 p.m. to 4:30 p.m.

After January 14, while these large organizations are registering their personnel, no walk-in registrations will be allowed. Once all Fort Gordon units have registered, open registration will resume for all retirees and other DoD personnel not registered.

Activation of the system is anticipated in summer 2013, so ID cardholders who are not able to register by Jan. 14 will have ample time left to register after units complete registration. Retirees and other personnel who didn't get an opportunity to register prior to activation may still enter the installation through the visitor's lane by showing their ID cards to a guard.
