FORT GORDON, GA – The Signal Center and the Augusta Recruiting Battalion will conduct a Technology Expo Thursday, April 15, 8a.m. to 2 p.m. for approximately 750 high school students from 13 area school districts.

The purpose is to introduce various Army developmental and career opportunities available to young men and women.

The exposition will be in two phases. The first phase 8 to 10 a.m. consists of students arriving at Alexander Hall receiving a briefing, orientation, historical highlights of the Signal Corps and presentations by Army leaders. The second phase consists of lunch and demonstrations of job opportunities in the Signal Corps and the Army.

Students will see a “Digital TOC” operations and coordination center, satellite communications training, router network training systems trouble shooting, video teleconference, data network capabilities, modern war fighting capabilities and K-9 demonstrations.
