FORT GORDON SURVIVOR SERVICES IS COMING TO ATHENS

FORT GORDON, GA – The Fort Gordon, Georgia Survivor Outreach Services (SOS) program is coming to the Athens area. The goal of the event is to reach family members of those who have died in war. The meeting is open to all Survivors including Active Duty, National Guard and Army Reserves.

For the majority of Survivors, Fort Gordon, GA is more than 50 miles away. More than one-third of these Survivors live three hours or more away from the installation. The SOS staff wants to meet these Survivors and provide an opportunity for them to meet each other. Each meeting will include an overview of the Survivor Outreach Services program plus information on the financial and benefits assistance that is available to Survivors. A survivor Forum will be conducted as a means to solicit feedback from the Survivors about their needs and perspective on the Army's Casualty Assistance process.

The meetings in Athens, GA will be held on Monday, May 3 at 1 p.m. and again at 6 p.m. at the First United Methodist Church, 327 N. Lumpkin Street.
