SENATOR ISAKSON TO VISIT FORT GORDON AND EISENHOWER ARMY MEDICAL CENTER

FORT GORDON, GA – U.S. Senator Johnny Isakson (GA-R) will visit and tour Fort Gordon and Dwight D. Eisenhower Army Medical Center on Tuesday, June 1. He will be provided an update on missions, programs, construction and other issues of significance to the installation and hospital commands. Senator Isakson will be hosted and escorted by Brigadier General Jeffrey Foley, commanding general, U.S. Army Signal Center of Excellence and Fort Gordon, as well as Colonel Glenn Kennedy, Fort Gordon Garrison Commander.

Following briefings and a tour of the installation, Isakson, a member of the U.S. Senate Veterans Affairs Committee, will visit the hospital's Neuroscience Center to view treatment provided through its Traumatic Brain Injury and Post Traumatic Stress Disorder program.
