#### NEW COMMANDING GENERAL FOR 7<sup>th</sup> SIGNAL COMMAND (THEATER)

FORT GORDON, GA – The Army Chief of Staff announced today the assignment of Brigadier General Lawarren V. Patterson as the next commanding general of 7<sup>th</sup> Signal Command (Theater) replacing Brigadier General Jennifer L. Napper, who has commanded the organization since 2008. BG Patterson is currently assigned as Deputy General, United States Army Network Enterprise Technology Command, Fort Huachuca, Arizona.

The 7<sup>th</sup> Signal Command (Theater), headquartered at Fort Gordon, Georgia, provides and defends network capabilities and services for Army, Joint, Interagency and Multinational Forces throughout the Western Hemisphere.
