35TH SIGNAL BRIGADE UNITS RETURN FROM IRAQ

FORT GORDON, GA – The Headquarters of the 35th Signal Brigade and all of the 67th Expeditionary Signal Battalion, approximately 600 soldiers, will return from an 11 month deployment to Iraq, Wednesday and Thursday, July 14 and 15, to meet with their families at Gym #5, on 26th Street.

While in Iraq, the 35th Signal Brigade assumed authority of the largest tactical signal mission throughout the Multi-National Corps – Iraq. The 35th Signal Brigade was responsible for more than 40 sites spread across 17 provinces in Iraq.

On their return home, the Headquarters of the 35th Signal Brigade will have completed two tours in Iraq, while the 67th Signal Battalion will have three tours. Elements of the 67th Signal Battalion were also deployed in September 2005 to Camp Shelby, Mississippi and New Orleans to set up and maintain communications after Hurricane Katrina.

There will be two Welcome Home Ceremonies in Gym #5 as follows:

Day 1 - July 14, Wednesday, 5:50 p.m., 300 personnel – 35th Sig BDE and 67th Sig Bn

Day 2 – July 15, Thursday, 5:50 p.m., 260 personnel – 35th Sig BDE and 67th Sig Bn
