U.S. ARMY SIGNAL CENTER CHANGE OF COMMAND

FORT GORDON, GA – Brigadier General Jeffrey W. Foley will relinquish command of the U.S. Army Signal Center of Excellence and Fort Gordon to Brigadier General Alan R. Lynn at a ceremony to be held at Fort Gordon at 8 a.m., Wednesday, July 21, 2010 on Barton Field.

BG Foley has been the installation's commanding general since July 2007. He is a 1978 graduate of the United States Military Academy at West Point, N.Y. He has served in the Army for 32 years, and in his honor, a formal retirement ceremony will be held at the conclusion of the change of command. He is the Army's 34th Chief of Signal in this, the 150th anniversary of the creation of the Signal Corps.

BG Lynn is currently Commander, 311th Signal Command, Fort Shafter, Hawaii.
