#### SEPTEMBER 11 REMEMBRANCE

FORT GORDON, GA – Friday, September 10, Fort Gordon will observe two minutes of silence in memory of the nearly three thousand who died in the September 11, 2001 attacks on the World Trade Center, the Pentagon and in Pennsylvania.

8:35 a.m. – Emergency vehicles will be positioned at key intersections and all gates on Fort Gordon.

8:40 a.m. – All civilians and soldiers will move outside, where mission requirements allow.

8:45 a.m. – Two minutes of silence begins.

8:46 a.m. – Sirens will sound simulating the first strike on the World Trade Center.

8:48 a.m. – Ceremony at the Signal Towers Flag Pole to lower the U.S. Flag to half staff and taps played.
