### THE 2010 SIGNAL CONFERENCE

FORT GORDON, GA – Approximately 400 attendees that include general officers and other senior military service members, senior civilians and communication network architects are expected at the 2010 Fort Gordon Signal Conference from Monday, Nov. 29 to Friday, Dec. 3.

The Signal Conference theme is “Signal Corps of the Future.” The purpose of the conference is to inform selected world-wide members of the war fighting community on emerging technologies and providing the Defense Department a means of protecting crucial government information networks and combating cyber threats worldwide.

Major General Rhett Hernandez, commanding general of the Armed Forces Cyber Command (ARCYBER), headquartered in Fort Meade, Md., will speak at the conference. With a command strength of 21,000 soldiers and civilians around the globe, ARCYBER is the Army’s component of U.S. Cyber Command (USCYBER), with the mission of fusing the Department of Defense’s full spectrum of cyberspace operations.

There will also be a Signal Corps Regimental Run on Wednesday, Nov. 1 on Barton Field at 6 a.m. in honor of the 2010 Signal Conference.
